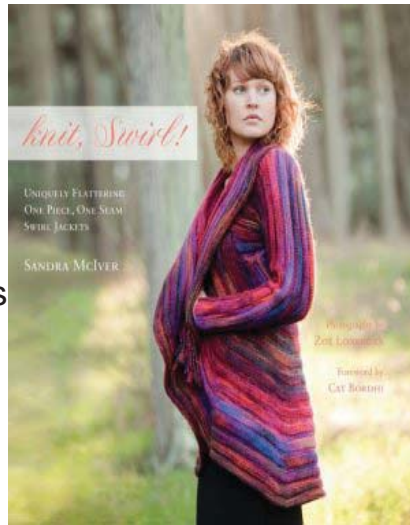


Sign up for Classes
